

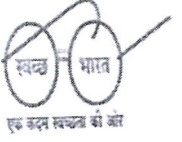

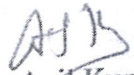

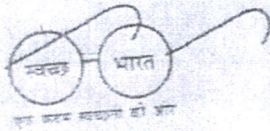

Sir/Madam,

Malaria, Dengue & Chikungunya are the disease acquired by the bite of infected mosquitoes. Prevention of Mosquito breeding is the only effective means for prevention and control of Dengue, Malaria & Chikungunya. Mosquitoes usually breed in stagnant water or places like desert coolers, uncovered tanks, old tires, or any other articles holding water in domestic and peridomestic settings.

In this regard, Govt./Autonomous offices/Educational Institutions/Commercial Concerns/Market Association/RWAs are requested to take measures for prevention and control of mosquito breeding. Aedes mosquito breeding in offices & workplaces is of concern and your cooperation is solicited to help in controlling the breeding of mosquitoes. Head of all Govt. Offices/Institutions/Commercial & residential complexes are requested to take the following action regularly:-

- All coolers should be cleaned once a week and mopped dry before refilling.
- In coolers that cannot be emptied, put one tablespoon of Temephos Granules.
- Nodal officers from Govt. offices may contact the AMO Office at PUHC Narela to obtain Temephos Granules.
- Overhead and other water storage tanks should be kept properly covered.
- Collection of stagnant water should not be allowed inside or around office premises and if the same does take place, Temephos Granules may be put in such stagnant water collection.
- Unused/ broken bottles, cups, pots, and tires that can hold water should not be left in the open.
